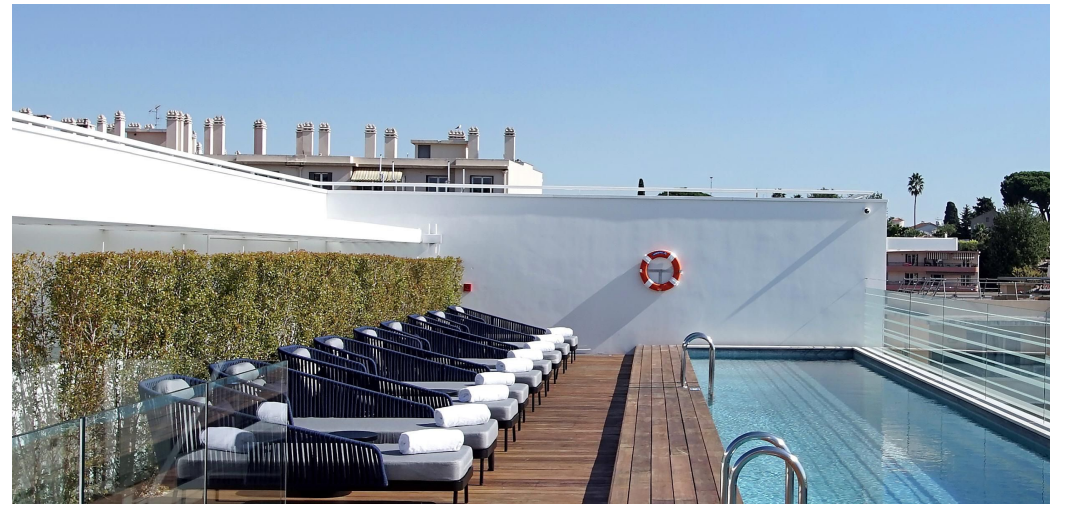
Hotel Indigo also has a gym and a relaxing treatment area, two meeting rooms equipped with daylight.

CAGNES-SUR-MER



Cagnes-sur-Mer is a commune in southeastern France, located west of Nice at only 8 km from Nice (10 mn by coach).

Ideally located near St Paul de Vence, Cannes and Nice, and the charming old village (walking distance from hotel)

Its modern hippodrome town, its fishing village called Le Cros-de-Cagnes, is a sweet blend of tradition and modernity. Here you can also visit the famous Chateau Grimaldi in the Museum of Modern Art! The castle rises 90 meters above sea level and has a medieval town.

From there you can admire the city and enjoy exceptional panoramic views of the Mediterranean Sea and the Alps.

Auguste Renoir, the famous painter, set down his suitcases in 1907 in Cagnes sur Mer. The Renoir Museum bears witness to the universe of the Impressionist master. The last residence of the painter fascinates by its authenticity and its historical character, its original paintings and its unpublished sculptures to discover during a walk
Cagnes-sur-Mer also offers beach restaurants and dynamic shops, and the Nice airport is only at 8 minutes by bus.



Renoir Museum – St Paul-de-Vence & Marc Chagall Museum & Tourettes sur Loup

SDome ideas for visits.

The Renoir Museum (500 m) is located in the heart of a magnificent estate planted with olive and citrus trees, where you can find wonderful panoramic views all the way to Cap d'Antibes. With its collection, 14 original canvases, 40 sculptures, furniture and workshops... it is a moving testament to the creativity of the Impressionist master.

La Promenade des Arts (1.7 km) and the Crosiin de Cagnes area, a 200-year-old quarter also known as the "Fisherman's Town".

SAINT-PAUL DE VENCE (6km) - Marc Chagall Museum

Marc Chagall never stopped traveling throughout his life, in exile and on his travels. From the shores of Divna to the shores of the Mediterranean, from the walls of Jerusalem to the ramparts of Saint-Paul de Vence...

Saint-Jeannet (13 km) has long been a land of vines and wine. The grape festival rivaled the patron festival before the vines disappeared to be replaced by flower gardens.

Located 13 km from the sea between Nice and Cannes, **Tourettes-sur-Loup** is a charming medieval village that deserves a detour.

Tourettes-sur-Loup is located on a cliff in the middle of wonderful and abundant vegetation, where aloes and figs grow naturally.

It is called the "City of Violets" because this beautiful and shy flower has been cultivated there for almost a century. It is still one of the most important activities in the village.
